

# BULKY ITEM PICK-UP

The City of Okmulgee provides a limited monthly bulky item pick-up service for residential utility account holders. For the purpose of this service program, a bulky item is defined as a single item that is generally too large to be carried by one person. Each utility account holder is eligible to request a bulky item pick-up for not more than 3 bulky items up to 4 times during each calendar year.

## Examples of BULKY ITEMS accepted are:

### Furniture:

Sofas  
Chairs  
Stove  
Tables  
Mattresses & Box Springs  
Dressers

### Appliances:

Washers  
Dryers  
Furnace  
Dishwasher  
Hot Water Tanks

### Miscellaneous Items:

Carpet and Carpet Pad  
Lumber (NO LIMBS, BRUSH or Construction Debris)  
Treadmills

## Examples of BULKY ITEMS NOT accepted are:

Refrigerators, Freezers, and Air Conditioners      Construction Debris      Sinks      Vacuums  
Hazardous materials      Tires      Trash bags      Small Grills

Electronics and other items for which the City provides recycling opportunities

## THE FOLLOWING PICK-UP SCHEDULE WILL BE FOLLOWED:

If your regular trash day is Monday the Bulky Item Pick-up will be 1<sup>st</sup> Friday each month

If your regular trash day is Tuesday the Bulky Item Pick-up will be 2nd Friday each month

If your regular trash day is Wednesday the Bulky Item Pick-up will be 3rd Friday each month

If your regular trash day is Thursday the Bulky Item Pick-up will be 4th Friday each month

**BULKY ITEM PICK-UP SERVICE WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE ON CITY HOILDAYS.**

## TO SCHEDULE A BULKY ITEM PICK-UP:

- You will need to call the Okmulgee Public Works Department on Wednesday of your pick-up week before 3:00 p.m. at 918-756-4159 to schedule the pick-up. If you DO NOT make an appointment NO PICK-UP will be provided.
- Make sure your most recent utility bill has been paid in full by the due date prior to scheduling your pickup with Public Works. **NO PICKUP WILL BE MADE FOR ACCOUNT HOLDERS WHO HAVE UNPAID UTILITY BILLS.**
- Place the bulky item(s) scheduled for pickup at the curb (or edge of street) not earlier than the afternoon on the day prior to scheduled pickup and not later than 7:00AM of the scheduled pickup day.
