The Site, which is located just east of Muskogee Street and south of Box Avenue, is part of a Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) initiative between the ODEQ and OXY. This cooperative agreement to address impacts at the Site began in 2010 with numerous investigations to determine areas requiring cleanup. Glenn Springs Holdings (GSH), a subsidiary of OXY, and their contractors are in the process of finalizing the cleanup plan with the ODEQ which will consist of the removal of these impacted areas and subsequent disposal at an off-site state approved landfill. GSH will host a community meeting to discuss the cleanup plan and associated activities.
